

April 24: Colts No-hit Bowie, Triumph 13-1

Kelsie Dancer pitched four no-hit innings, striking out seven, and Gary Lopez pitched the last inning of the combined no-hitter as the Colts snapped a four game skid with a 13-1 rout of Bowie. Jake Landrith provided a big portion of the offense going 3 for 3 and driving in four, including a first inning ground rule double that scored Kelsie Dancer and Lawrence Brandt, who both reached base in all three of their at-bats. Gavin Hawbaker, who caught the last few games after Chris Burnett's football-related injury, had two hits, keying a two-run second, and contributing to the nine-run third inning rally that put the game away. Duane Hughes also had a couple of hits, and Brennan Kelly had one, and both were among the eight different Colts scoring runs.
