

March 24 AHS Freshman Annihilate Sam Houston 25-1

In a game that invoked memories of YMCA summer league baseball combined with the Alamo, the freshman ended their 4-game skid with a 25-1 massacre of the Texans. Kelsie Dancer and Omar Frias combined on a one-hit nine-strikeout effort in the 4-inning mercy-rule-ended game, and 16 Colts got in on the action, with 13 scoring at least one run, and 11 knocking in at least one. The Colts scored six in the first, eleven in the fourth, and four runs in each of the two middle innings, yielding only one unearned run. Gavin Hawbaker had a notable offensive performance, going 2 for 4, including a double, 3 runs, 3 RBI's, and a stolen base.
