

Colts Edge Summit 3-2

AHS April 20, 2010. The Arlington Colts JV team eked out a 3-2 victory over Summit. The Jaguars drew first blood using a couple singles and a walk off Colts starter Sean Moore to take a 1-0 lead in the opening frame. Despite outhitting Summit 10-3, the Colts had difficulty scoring, squandering a few early opportunities with base running blunders. Still trailing 1-0 with two outs and none on in the bottom of the third, Matt Barber doubled to start the winning rally followed by a bunt single by Tyler Rice. Then the old first and third pick-off play went horribly wrong for Summit with a balk tying the score. Lawrence Brandt then roped a 3-0 single to right to score Rice giving the Colts the lead. Brandt then scored the eventual winning run motoring in from first on Matt Juarez's gapper. Summit did not go easily, drawing to within a run in the fourth, but Omar Frias pitched two scoreless innings to earn the save, striking out the final Jaguar with the potential tying run on third. The 3-2 victory was the Colts second one run victory over Summit, and improved their overall record to 13-7 (6-3 in district).
