

Colts Blast Bowie Again 14-4

Bowie April 23, 2010. The Arlington Colts JV team run-ruled Bowie for the second time this season, this time by a 14-4 margin. The Colts took a 1-0 lead in the second when Adam Noonkester singled and scored. Adam, who was also in the middle of a 5 run rally in the third that featured hits by backstop Clayton Johnson and shortstop Nathan Rowe, had a big day going 3-3 with three runs and three RBI's. Number 3 ran his streak of consecutive at-bats without making an out to eight, including six singles, and an HBP. After Bowie rallied to close the gap to 6-3 off starting and winning pitcher Ashby Dean, the Colts tacked on eight more runs in an unusual fourth inning rally. Clayton Johnson singled and was out stealing second, Austin McKinney (back off the DL in a big way reaching base in all four at-bats), walked, stole second and was out stealing third, so with two out and nobody on the next seven batters all had base hits including doubles by Jeff Queary and Sean Moore; by the time the final out was recorded 11 straight Colts had reached base. Jordan Miller held Bowie in check over the last couple innings to finish off the 14-4 victory.
