

Colts Put One in the Win Column 7-3

Lamar Feb. 25, 2010. The Arlington Colts JV team notched their first victory with a 7-3 domination of Trinity. Starting pitcher Omar Frias threw a five inning complete game, striking out 7, and also starred at the plate going 2-3 with three RBI's. Left fielder Austin McKinney walked, stole a base, and later scored staking the Colts to an early lead. They added a second run in the third when first baseman Lawrence Brandt singled in center fielder Kelsie Dancer. The lead was 2-1 in the fourth when the Colts added four runs to break the game open, featuring big hits by Frias and McKinney and a clout by Dancer that would have gone out if not for a stiff head wind. A large Trinity player hit two-run homer through a brief lull in the wind to close it to 6-3, but Frias singled in Eddie Lozano to complete the scoring, and then slammed the door on the Trojans with Brandt running down a pop-up in foul ground for the final out.
