

Martin Cools off Colts 7-3

AHS March 13, 2010. The Arlington Colts JV team was defeated by Martin 7-3 in the championship game of the AHS tournament. Colts starting pitcher Jordan Miller, just off the disabled list with a broken nose (you should see the other guy) gave up a couple hits to start the game, but settled down retiring 6 of the next 7 batters. The score was 1-0 in the third when a sinking line drive eluded the right fielder opening the door for a three-run Martin rally, capped by three singles off reliever Ashby Dean. After extending the lead to 5-0 in the fourth, the Warriors loaded the bases with an error and two walks in the 5th off reliever Lawrence Brandt. A run scored on a nifty 5-4-3 double play and a bloop single put the Martin advantage at 7-0. Meanwhile, the Colts bats were silenced by the Martin hurler, with the only hits being a Matt Juarez single in the 2nd and double in the 5th through the first 4 2/3 innings. Two out walks by Tyler Rice and Eddie Lozano loaded the bases for pinch hitter Omar Frias, whose rocket to deep left center cleared the bases, putting the Colts back in the game at 7-3. Relievers Jeremy Cook and Austin McKinney kept Martin off the scoreboard in the final two innings, but the Colts were not able to push any more runs across, despite getting two runners on in each inning. The second place finish was still a fine achievement for the home team, whose overall record now stands at 7 wins and 4 losses.
