

Colts Bury Newman Smith 21-7

The Arlington Colts JV team routed Newman Smith using a strong ground game and a bunch of turnovers on their way to a two touchdown victory 21-7 in the opener of the Irving tournament. Austin McKinney and Adam Noonkester both singled and scored in the first inning to pace starter Omar Frias to a 2-0 lead.
